

Carpet Tile and Multi-Flooring Adhesive

Description

R&D 73 Premium Pressure Sensitive Flooring Adhesive is a water based, low VOC, trowelable adhesive designed for all types of carpet tile and vinyl flooring. It can be applied as a permanent or releasable bond. It is suitable for use over concrete and exterior grade plywood, as well as properly installed radiant heat systems. Its low VOC content makes it ideal for use in buildings that are occupied.

Limitations

- For interior use only
- Do not use over non-pourous surfaces
- Substrate and room temperature should be maintained at 20°C (70°F) while installing flooring
- Protect from freezing

- Approximately 175 sq.ft. (16 m²) per U.S.
 Gallon (3.78 Litres) using a 1/16" X 1/16" X 1/16" notched trowel
- Coverage will vary depending on substrate and trowel size

Application

R&D 73 Premium Pressure Sensitive Flooring Adhesive may be used on all clean, dry, level, crack free, solid subfloors. It may be either troweled or rolled onto the subflooring. Place the flooring material into the adhesive while wet if a more permanent bond is required. For a releasable installation, allow the adhesive to fully dry (up to 3 hours) or until the film becomes semi-clear before laying the floor covering. Apply pressure immediately after installation to ensure good contact, using a heavy roller. Begin at one side of the covered area and then roll again at right angles to the first direction.

Always follow installation instructions of the flooring manufacturer.

Clean Up

Wet adhesive can be cleaned up with water and a damp cloth. Dried adhesive can be cleaned with mineral spirits.
